Search box - type words which relate to the image that you are searching. Click "search"

"Login" or "Register" to add images to your lightbox

Add image to your lightbox by clicking Add to lightbox

You can further filter your search results. For instance you may want to see images that only have a "climber" in it. Type in: climber and click "go".

You would then see images of "New Zealand mountains, covered in snow with climbers.

Filter results by orientation, very useful for finding vertical images for Front Covers.

Clicking on the thumbnail image, pops-up a larger preview image.

# *www.hedgehoghouse.com – how to request a quote & order images*

To request a quote or to order images, you need to have logged in or registered and added image(s) to your lightbox.

Click on lightboxes, and the images you have added will display.

If you wish to have all images quoted / ordered click the button “Check all images”.

Select individual images by manually clicking on the “tick box” next to “Include in Quote”.
